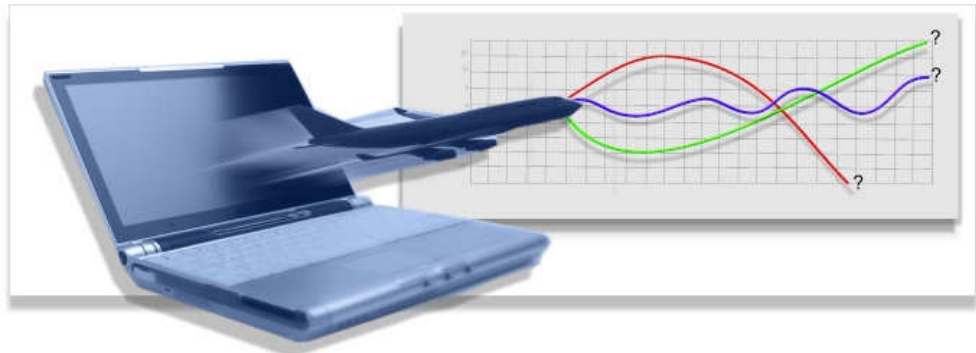

Day 1: Introducing Systems Thinking and System Dynamics: resource structures and simulation foundations

Systems thinking and system dynamics overview - resource structures and stock/flow diagrams - feedback loops and influence diagrams - recurring archetype structures and behaviours - introduction to *iThink*[®] - human resource simulation development exercises - short case study in resource strategy simulation - overnight resource mapping exercises.

Day 2: Practical strategy simulation development

Debrief of overnight mapping exercises - introduction to simulation conceptualisation principles – overview of the strategy simulation process.

Case study: Issue definition - the management team engagement process - qualitative resource and feedback mapping - quantitative *iThink* simulation development - adding financial scorekeeping - adding a management interface.

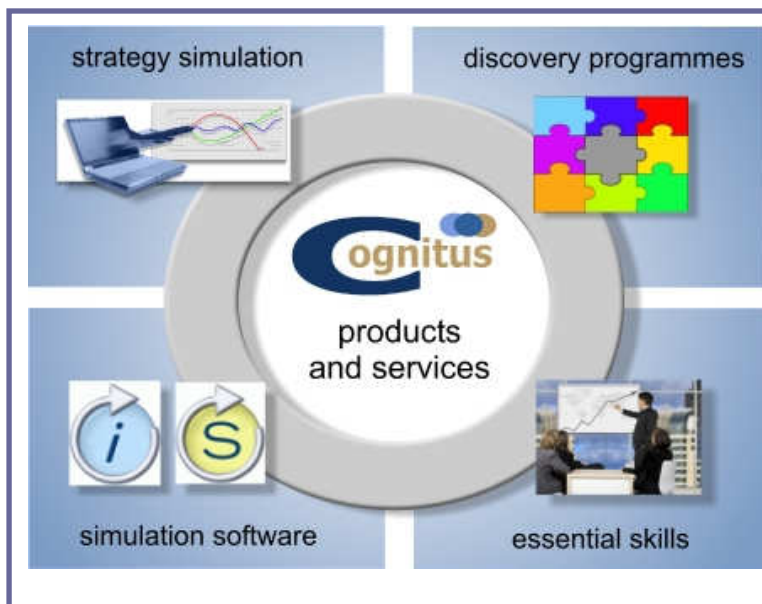
